## FACTS, FEES, & INFORMATION

Camp Chandler-Tonsmeire programs and activities are specifically planned and carefully coordinated by the camp's professional staff. Each of Camp Chandler-Tonsmeire weekly sessions will deliver on the promise that families expect from an excellent summer camp experience.

### HOURS OF OPERATION

The program will run Monday-Friday and will open no earlier than 7:30 AM and close no later than 5:30 PM. Parents picking up late will be assessed a late fee.

### COST & REGISTRATION FEE

The week session fees of \$65 per child. Families can set-up payment plans to ensure the camp fee is paid in advance. Ask about our discounts for additional children. \$55 non-refundable registration fee due with application.

### CAMP PREVIEW DAYS

Camp preview days are on April 15 and May 20 for families to tour the grounds and learn more about the offerings of the camp.

### WHO CAN ATTEND?

Your child can attend if they are in grades 1-8. If your child is 13 and older, please inquire about our Counselor in Training program.

### MEDICATIONS

All children must have a doctor sign the provided health forms. Please ensure detailed information is provided on the medical forms.

### DRESS CODE

Please dress your child appropriately for a mix of daily activities. The camp will follow same dress code guidelines as Public Schools.

### MEALS

Lunch and snack will be provided for your child each day. Notify staff of any food allergies!

### SWIMMING

Your child will be going swimming during the week. Please have your child bring: towel, non-revealing swim suit, swim gear, change of clothing and undergarments. There are lifeguards on site.
